RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1- **ALL COMPETITORS MUST SIGN THE WAIVER CONDITION** - liability condition of our insurance policy which covers 3rd party liability not competitors.
- 2- All entries must be in by August 1 **Blocks may not be available after this date.**
- 3- **ENTRY FEE** - \$5.00 per event for all entries received by August 1. \$10.00 per event for entries received after August 1, Fees are payable with entry or at registration.
- 4- In order to qualify, all contestants must register by 5 PM for Friday events and by 9AM for Saturday and Sunday events. Eliminations will start promptly at 10 AM on Saturday and 9:30 AM on Sunday. Competitors not present for their qualification events will be disqualified from that event.
- 5- All CANLOG Rules will apply.
- 6- Power Saws will not be run during the show, except during stated competition. There will be a designated area and time to run alcohol saws.
- 7- Contestants over 16 must be **CANLOG** members. (memberships available at show)
- 8- Contestants may not enter a **DIVISION** lower than their current rating in any event.
Open World Championship Relay: Competitors must be classified "Open" in one of the two chopping disciplines to enter this event.
- 9 Contestants entering **AXE THROW** must enter at least one other event.
- 10- The decision of the contest judges will be final in any and all matters pertaining to the contests and their rules committee may in it's absolute discretion disqualify or otherwise deal with any competitor in any event in such circumstances and on such grounds as it may deem adequate.
- 11- To avoid scheduling conflicts due to sharing of equipment, you must note what events you will be sharing equipment for and with whom the equipment is to be shared. Heats will be run as posted. If show center is unaware of equipment sharing and you are listed in the same heat as the competitor you are sharing with, only one of you will compete. Heats will not be changed due to equipment sharing.
- 12- Competition wood species are Western White Pine and Red Alder

CANADA / UNITED STATES CHALLENGE

For our 50th anniversary Festival the Salmon Festival was considering what Logging Sports competition would be suitable to celebrate this milestone. As a world Class Logging Sports, we have competitors coming from various countries with a number of them hailing from United States. We also noticed, when it comes to placing in the top 5 of an event, they are basically on par with Canadians, with some capturing 1st place.

Given the above, it was decided that a challenge between Canadian and United States Logging Sports competitors would be a great 50th Anniversary event. Besides a fantastic event, it would be an opportunity for each country to determine if they have the best Logging Sports Competitors.

Along with this challenge, we also want to provide an opportunity for competitors from other countries or those not wanting to enter the competition, so the following was developed:

- 1 – The Challenge events will be the Open, Ladies, and Mixed events on Sunday and can be entered by anyone from anywhere.
- 2 – To qualify as a Canada / United States Challenge Event, a minimum of 2 competitors from both countries must enter.
- 3 – Scoring will be 1 point for the country who's competitor places the highest in the challenge event.
